



### **Attending Lean Six Sigma trainees Projects gallery walk at 13<sup>th</sup> “Six Sigma” training wave**

The Business Process Development Team, in collaboration with SSA&C, held the second week of the 13<sup>th</sup> training Wave to train employees from the company and other oil companies to acquire the Green Belt certificate in using Six Sigma Methodology, taking place from 19<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> of November 2017. With total number 22 participants (Twelve employees from PIC, four employees from GPIC, four employees from Kuwait Oil Company (KOC) and two employees from Kuwait Petroleum Corporation (KPC)).

Lean Six Sigma gallery walk for all trainees was held on November 22<sup>nd</sup>, in the presence of the directors and heads of the departments of the company and the participating companies. The trainees presented their projects and the stages that were completed, as well as they shows the expected benefits from the implementation of these projects.

It is worth mentioning that by the end of this course, the number of those who have been trained to obtain the Green Belt certification in Lean Six Sigma Methodology has reached 141 employees from within the company and 74 employees from the oil companies. This course qualifies the trainees to understand and apply the Lean Six Sigma Methodology in managing and implementing various improvement projects and progress of the level of operations and quality of the company.
